2. Overview of normal thyroid ultrasound/Doppler-ultrasound. The normal thyroid gland is in the neck's infra-hyoid visceral space . It produces the hormones T3 and T4, which have well-known important roles in growth and metabolism regulation. The normal thyroid parenchyma is divided in multiple lobules, each one composed of 20 to 40 follicles with variable diameters.

Normal Coronal . Normal sagittal at the 3rd and 4th ventricles. Normal anterior coronal neonatal brain. Scan, angling forward of this point as far as possible to the 'bulls-horns' of the sphenoid bone. Normal parasagittal at the lateral ventricles. Normal mid-anterior coronal at the sylvian fissures and 3rd ventricle. Normal far-posterior coronal.

This 3 vessel view (ultrasound and color Doppler video) of the fetal heart in early 3rd trimester shows the Pulmonary artery- PA dividing into the right and left pulmonary arteries and continuing as the ductus arteriosus to meet the arch of aorta in a V shape (with the arch). The SVC is the superior vena cava and

Ascending aorta (AO) is seen continuing as the Arch to meet the ductus arteriosus (forming the characteristic V shape).

Knowledge of the normal prostatic anatomy is paramount to understanding the pathological conditions of the gland observed on ultrasound imaging. Through transverse and sagittal histological sections of normal prostates, model ultrasound images of the prostate and periprostatic tissues were constructed. Gross anatomy. Each gland is enclosed in the perirenal fascia and each has a body and two limbs: a medial limb and a lateral limb. However, the right adrenal gland is usually more pyramidal in shape while the left adrenal gland is more crescentic 7 . The right adrenal gland has a maximum width of 6.1 mm and the left adrenal gland has a maximum width of 7.9 mm 6.

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
